

PSTS delivers 2 Mobile Harbour Cranes of 100 tons capacity each at Kandla Port.

PSTS successfully delivered 2 Mobile Harbour cranes of 100 tons capacity each at Kandla Port which stands first in the hierarchy of 12 major ports in India, it is the major seaport of west coast.

The project was part of international tender under the Prime Minister's special initiative to boost productivity at Kandla Port and was a huge challenge for the contractor in terms of pricing, logistics, documentation and timely delivery.

PSTS' Italian counterpart, Energy International Logistics Srl, teamed up with PSTS to deliver the same as single window operation covering freight, stevedoring, shore handling, customs broking and delivery. In order to keep timelines PSTS held a number of meetings with the contractor's local representatives in India. PSTS also extended a hand in testing equipment post-delivery to ensure client's full satisfaction.

The cargo consisted of two Mobile Harbour Cranes weighing 313 tons each; total of 6 grabs, 3 each of 22 cbm and 35 cbm capacity; and 10 counterweight of 270 tons. PSTS also arranged 3 airfreight shipments with accessories, spares and manuals. Cranes were supplied by Italgru, Italy and Grabs were supplied by Piener Smag, Germany.
